Onterra has created a preliminary proposed scope of work for creating an updated Comprehensive Lake Management Plan for North & South Twin Lakes. The proposal will be reviewed at Onterra and then sent to the NSTLRA team for review. Once we receive your approval, we will create the grant application that will be due December 10th.

In the past month, we have had many conversations with the WDNR about the restructured grant program and what that will mean for lakes like yours. While many lakes are going to now be ineligible for AIS-EPC Grants (the category that offers partial cost coverage for herbicide treatments), your system should align well with that grant program. As the WDNR has indicated, it is likely that you will be eligible to apply for this type of grant if you are working towards updating you Lake Management Plan. The AIS-EPC Grant application is due Feb 1, 2016. We will aim to have the 2015 AIS Monitoring Report completed sometime between Dec 10th and Feb 1st. This report will document the past efforts and propose a whole-lake herbicide treatment strategy for spring 2016.
